The OPTI-MOM Study will involve a screening visit and study visits which consist of questionnaires and simple blood draws. These visits will be performed at Magee-Womens Hospital, preferably at the time of your regularly scheduled appointments during the course of your pregnancy and after, in the postpartum period.
